## Profile

Participation of educationists, eminent personalities, experienced academicians and professionals from various fields has benefited the college with their expertise and knowledge and has enabled the college to maintain high standards as well as make critical progress every year.

St. Joseph's, with its visionary approach, is now recognized as a college which is imparting quality education and fulfilling varied academic needs of the students in a superior academic environment with modern infrastructure, amenities and latest equipments complementing the approach.

The well-thought out & scientifically designed curriculum by senior faculty has enabled the students to make optimum use of education and excel in their respective fields.

## Academic Programme

Intermediate Courses with MPC, BiPC (Eamcet / JEE / NEET) and CEC, MEC (CA/CMA/CS Foundation, CLAT / EDP) groups are offered in English Medium and as per the prescribed syllabus of Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana. The academic year begins from June till March.



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## Evaluation Scheme

The evaluation system is carried out in a planned way throughout the academic year by the Principal and respective faculty of each subject.

The students are continuously reminded to maintain 75% attendance as prescribed by the Board of Intermediate.

Regular tests are conducted after every chapter allowing them to check their comprehension of the topics. Besides these tests, quarterly, half-yearly and pre-final examinations are also conducted by the college.

In order to evaluate the academic progress of each student, the college regularly conducts parent-teacher meetings. Our faculty

maintains effective records for purposes of student assessment, evaluation of teaching, counseling of students, reporting to parents and recording critical incidents. The parents are welcome to contact the Principal and the teachers to discuss any academic matters of the student any time with prior appointment.

Considering the importance of Intermediate level of education, the college management has authorized 'Academic Counseling Board' (ACB) in adopting new updated teaching methodologies for our faculty.

The students are also given expert guidance to prepare themselves for entrance examinations and pursue future professional degrees & courses.







## The Teaching Faculty

Great teachers groom their students to become leaders and inspire them to seek their own path. They encourage them to discover their talents. And this is the philosophy of our faculty as well as management.

Our faculty provides the intellectual, social and emotional platform for the students to grow. They are not just portals to information but act as beacons of knowledge. Our faculty is trained to inspire curiosity and develop positive attitude plus present difficult concepts comprehensibly. They demonstrate creativity in teaching strategies and encourage student involvement. Working passionately, they foster critical thinking, listen to students and discover their educational needs. They value students' achievements and progress. Communicating effectively, acting with integrity and showing a caring attitude, they encourage students to achieve their goals.

## English Proficiency

The College realizes the importance of good communication skills and therefore lays great stress on student having above average vocal and written English at the time of admission itself. Students who fail to meet the minimum proficiency level required, upon admission to the College, will be assigned to special coaching classes offered by the English Department. Therefore, it is necessary that the students should have a good command on the English language even before they seek admission.



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## General Rules of the College

- Students should behave in a cultured manner reflecting the college atmosphere and in-sync with college's stature.
- Students should be attentive, punctual and regular to the classes.
- No student should indulge in activities, within or outside the campus, tarnishing the college name.
- Students should refrain from getting involved in demonstrations or union activities causing disruption to smooth functioning of the college.
- Using filthy language or writing slogans or graffiti on campus walls would attract immediate dismissal from the college.
- It is mandatory for students to carry their ID cards at all times

and to be produced when demanded by the college authorities.

- Students should be decently dressed and behave in a courteous and polite manner at all times and everywhere.
- It is mandatory for students to submit a leave letter, duly countersigned by the parents, for being absent from the college for any valid reason.
- Student's name will be removed from the college rolls if they remain absent without leave for a week.
- If leave is taken for more than a week, due to any medical reason, a medical certificate has to be produced, duly signed by a person not below the rank of an Assistant Civil Surgeon.

## Counseling

St. Joseph's Junior College realizes the social, psychological and academic jump a student undertakes when he enters the college life. To help the students make a smooth transition from school to college life, we have three different levels of counseling sessions viz. Full-time Counselors, College Academic Mentors & Peer Counselors.

Full-time Counselors: The College conducts counseling sessions

by high-profile academicians for the students, assisting them in their academics, personal and social life. They help by having result-oriented sessions and these sessions may include individual or group counseling, workshops and special programs. The special programs include development of academic skills, personal growth, anxiety desensitization, inter-personal skill building etc. These are designed to help the students overcome anxiety, fear, confusion, lethargy, loss of focus and fatigue.

## Admission Procedure

Admissions are based on SSC or its equivalent passing examination. The qualified applicant is accorded individual consideration through a comprehensive merit list prepared by the college.

The Admission Committee notifies the applicants of its decision to offer admission in the order of merit which will be displayed on the college notice board on specified dates.

1. An admission application form should be submitted at the office, on or before the prescribed date, along with non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 100/-
2. Xerox copies of scholastic records including S. S. C or its equivalent memos, Transfer certificate, Bonafide certificate, Sports & Extra-curricular certificates (if any) and Conduct

certificate etc., have to be submitted along with the Application form.

3. The candidates will be called for an interview on the prescribed dates to finalize the admission procedures.
4. On acceptance of an offer of admission, the candidates are required to pay the non-refundable fee which will be credited towards the first-year's fee of the 2-year program. Fee once paid will not be refunded or transferred under any circumstance.
5. The selected candidate should submit all the original certificates at the time of admission. The originals will not be returned to the candidate during the course of study.
